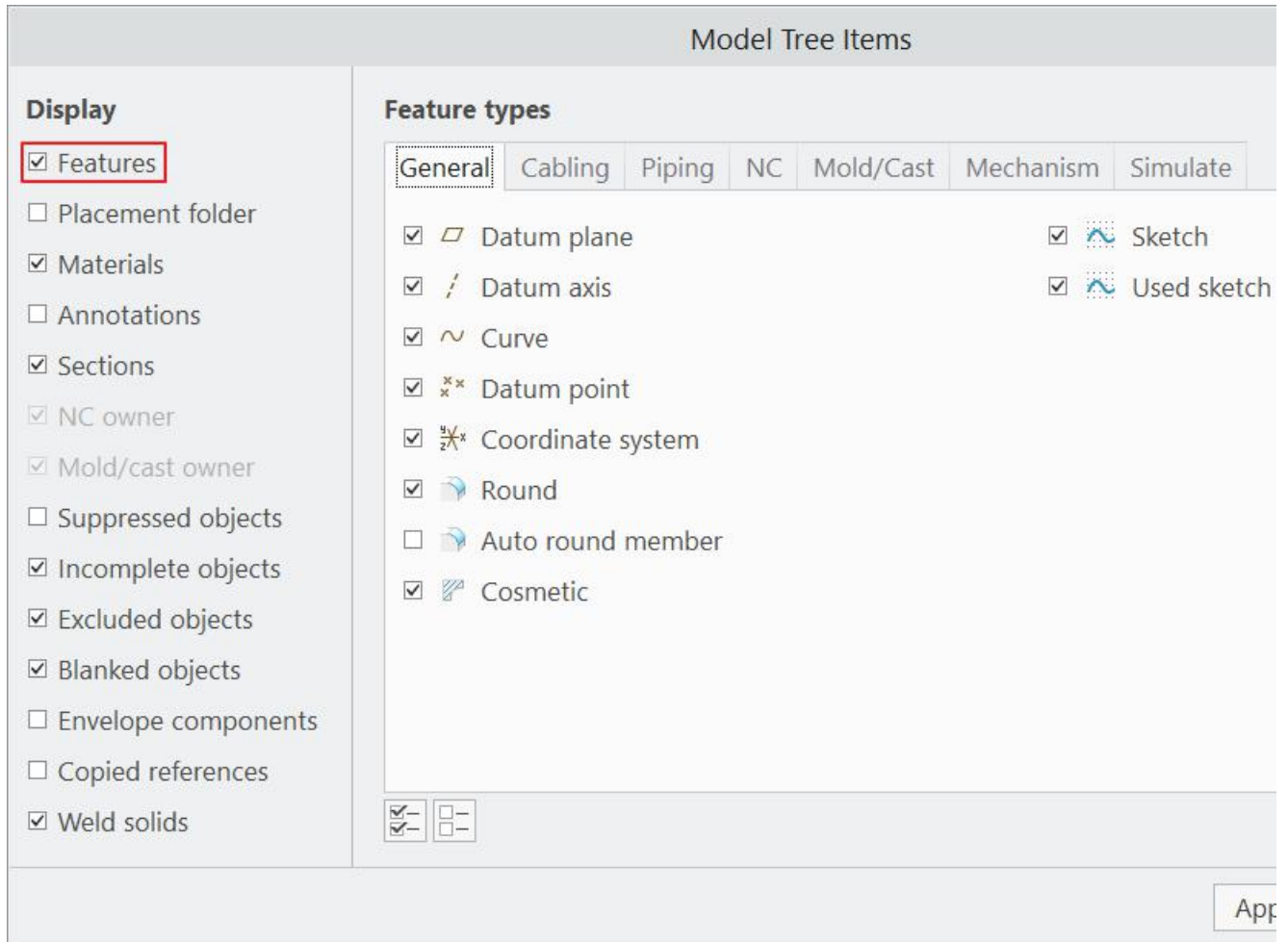
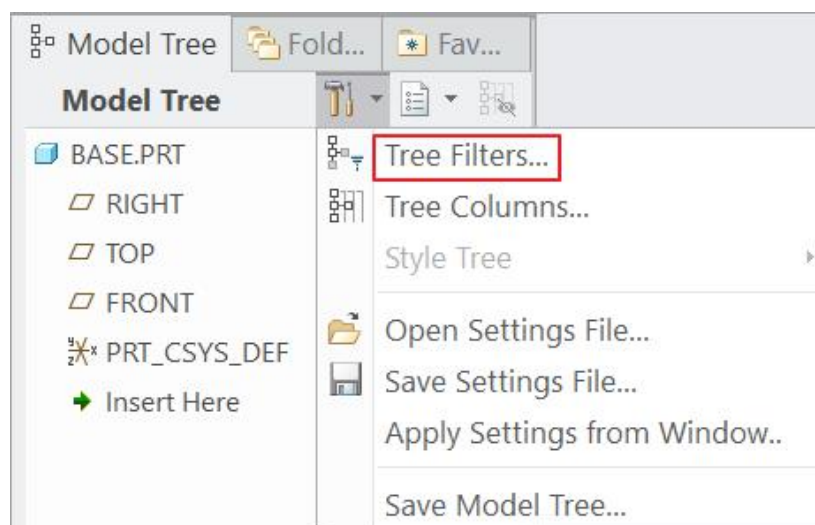


Please read the following points before starting the tutorials.

1. It is recommended to connect an additional monitor to the laptop or computer where you access the tutorials. You can display the Creo window on the additional monitor and tutorials on the original display. In this way a lot of time can be saved and following the tutorials become a lot easier.
2. Make sure that Features option is checked in Model Tree Items dialog box.
